Pet's presented for surgery that are not able to have a Spay/Neuter (already S/N, sick or injured) \$10 fee

Cherry eye:	\$75-\$95 per eye
Anal Gland expression:	\$15
Cryptorchid males:	Cost of neuter plus up to the full price of a spay for the same size
Dentals:	\$75+(Add'l fees may apply for IV fluids, extractions & antibiotics)will NOT call for approval up to \$150
Entropion:	\$125 per inverted eyelid (not all Dr. will do this at LCHS) (must be scheduled with S/N)
Enucleation:	\$100 (removal of damaged eye)
Tail amputation:	\$80-\$150 (medical need only)
Junior wellness profile:	\$55 dog Mini chemistry, CBC & heartworm test \$65 cat Mini chemistry, CBC & Leukemia/FIV test (under 7yrs)
Mass removal & biopsy:	\$130-\$300 per mass
Microchip:	\$25
Nail Trim:	(included with surgery) OR \$10 non-surgical appointment
Rear dewclaw removal:	\$30-\$45 per side at time of sterilization (additional \$20-30 without S/N)
Senior wellness profile:	\$115 (7+ yrs)DOG Chemistry/CBC/thyroid check/urinalysis & heartworm test
Senior wellness profile:	\$125 (7+ yrs)CAT Chemistry/CBC/thyroid check/urinalysis & Leukemia/FIV
Umbilical hernia:	\$45 cats and dogs under 20lbs/\$60 dogs over 20lbs (\$20 with sterilization)

- ✓ If a pet is found to be spayed after sedation, there will be a \$15.00 fee.
- ✓ Pregnant dogs & cats will be charged \$5.00 extra.
- ✓ If your female dog or cat had a litter recently please be sure that the puppies/kittens have been separated from mother for at least 2 weeks.
- ✓ Additional monies may be due the day of appointment for weight adjustment, if your female is in heat or pregnant or if you choose to have additional services performed.
- ✓ **Must provide current Rabies certificate (receipt or tag are insufficient) or purchase one for \$7**
- ✓ **Cats MUST come in a labeled carrier.**
- ✓ **No food after midnight** the night before surgery (water is okay).
- ✓ **Arrival time: 8:00am – 8:30am (Same day pick up. Must come within one hour of call.)**
- ✓ 825 Thornwood Dr., Heath OH 43056 (side door)

Thank you for trusting the Rascal Unit with the surgical care of your pet. The following information is designed to let you know what to expect on the day of your pet's procedure.

- All 30 (Dogs) or 50 (Cats) are dropped off at the same time (8:00 – 9:00 am). Surgeries are done throughout the day in random order. Your pet may go first, middle, or last at the vet's discretion.
- Due to the number of dogs/cats being dropped off we ask that you please limit the number of people arriving with the pet.
- Make sure you are available at the phone number you provided. We will call you if we have any questions.
- The person dropping the pet off must have knowledge about the pet in order to fill out pre-surgery paperwork at drop-off.
- We will call you when your pet is out of surgery.
- ALL animals must be picked up today within one hour of the pick-up call from an LCHS representative.
- If you fail to pick up your animal before the end of the day you will be charged a \$50 boarding fee. Please be courteous & prompt with pick-up. The LCHS staff & volunteers cannot leave until all animals are picked up.
- **Do not panic if we haven't called. Sometimes our day runs late. If you do not receive a call by 4 pm. Head to the shelter.**
- For **EMERGENCIES ONLY** you may call **740-323-2100** while your pet is in our care only.
- When you pick up your pet, you will be given oral and written instructions for after surgery care. Any additional monies due must be paid in cash at this time.
- Any appointment, once made and paid for, CANNOT be changed. If the owner either cancels or does a "No-Show" on the day of surgery, money **WILL NOT** be refunded.
- The low-cost clinics charge us a certain amount per clinic, if we do not have enough spots filled, they charge us anyway.
- Your pet needs to remain indoors, under restricted activity for 7 days after the surgery. (only 24 – 48 hours for feral cats)
- After pick-up please do not leave your pet unattended.
- ***IF A CLINIC HAS TO BE RE-SCHEDULED DUE TO INCLEMENT WEATHER, WE WILL CALL YOU TO RE-SCHEDULE. This is out of our control, and we will do our best to re-schedule you as soon as possible!!***
