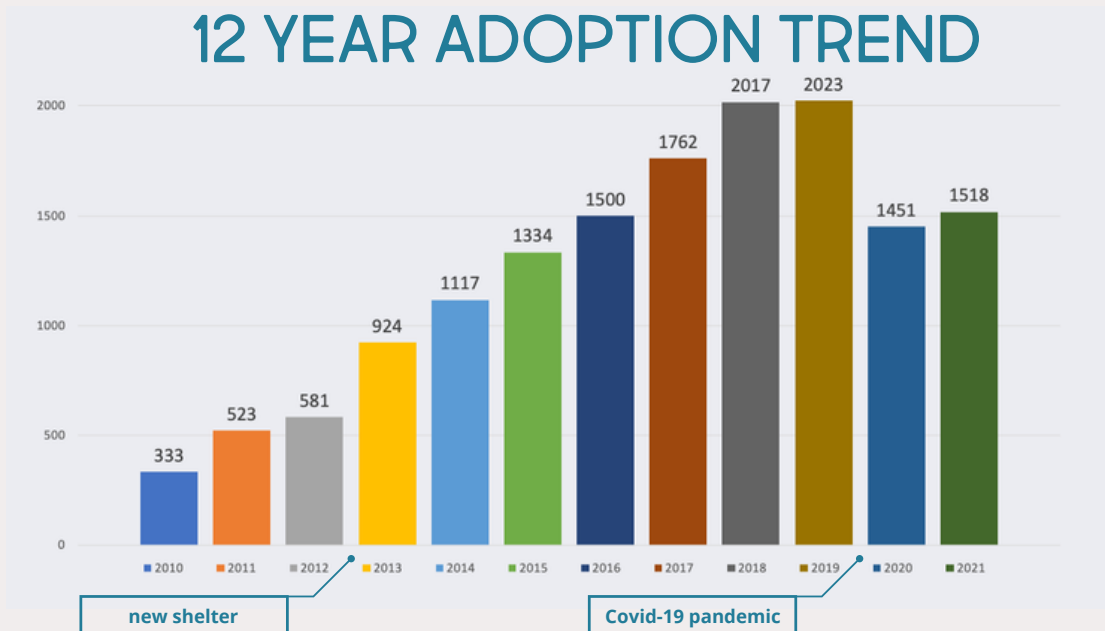

12 YEAR ADOPTION TREND

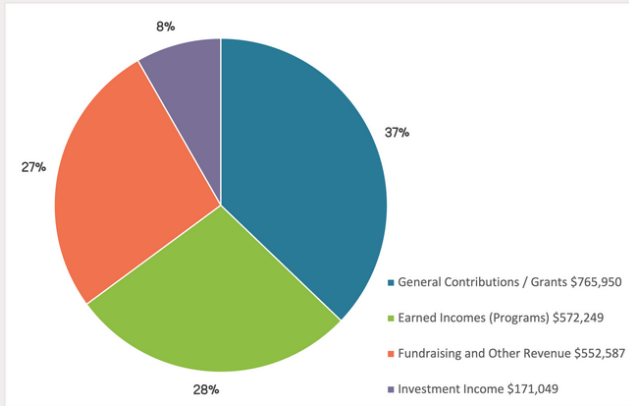


The Licking County Humane Society makes diligent efforts to balance our operations budget each year, and we have successfully achieved this goal for the last 7 years.

We are strong stewards of our resources.

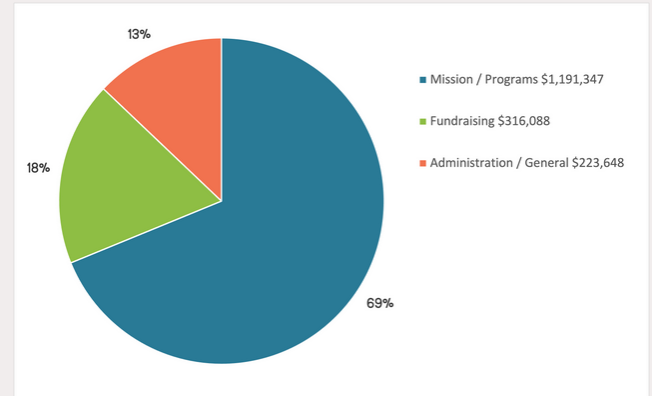

Pet Therapy Program - LCHS partners with multiple local assisted living facilities, schools, and other businesses throughout the community to bring adoptable dogs and cats to share the love that pets can provide to the residents, students, and employees at these locations.

Low-Cost Clinics - Our community clinics offer spay/neuter services, dental cleanings, and wellness & vaccination appointments all administered by our on-staff Licensed Ohio Veterinarians. A variety of surgical and non-surgical services are offered at these clinics which take place multiple times each month.



Dog Obedience Program - Gayle Mulvey is LCHS's Dog Training Instructor and she offers a variety of dog training classes for all levels. The classes are not just available for people who adopt from LCHS, any community member is encouraged to register.

Sophie's Thrift Store (625 Hebron Rd) - Sophie's Thrift relies on generous donations from our community of gently used items.
